GENERAL INFORMATION TO THE BEGINNING OF THE SCHOOL YEAR 2023/2024

First school day – 4th of September 2023 (non-uniform day)

9.00 a.m. introductory speech by the head teacher

(on the school playground or in the gym depending on the weather)

9.30 - 10.30 a.m. informative meeting with parents of Year 1 pupils and new pupils

9.30 – 11.30 a.m. activities for pupils with their class teachers

11.30 a.m. end of the first day, picking children up from the school

11.30 – 1.00 p.m. possibility of individual photoshoot of Year 1 pupils with parents

snacks for children will be provided by the school.

Important reminder and appeal regarding the organisation of parking during the first school day:

On this day, the capacity of our parking lot in the school area will be exceeded significantly. Therefore, we would like to ask parents who do not plan to attend the opening ceremony to drop off their children in front of the school, where the supervision will be organised by school. The remaining parents may consider parking their car on the surrounding streets. Thank you in advance for cooperation.

We would like to bring to your attention six important changes that we are introducing from this school year:

- Lessons will start at 8.15 a.m. on Mondays. Morning ellipsis will take place after the first lesson. 1.
- The end of the school day will be changed to 2:35 p.m. in case of 6 lessons. 2.
- 3. Pupils will have a lesson with a class teacher added to their lessons to focus on the development of children's character, attitudes and values.
- The Motivation System BESST will be suspended this school year. 4.
- We are introducing the option of payment through the EduPage application. 5.
- 6. Due to the settlements of the subsidies granted for the lunch taken, also Year 1 – 4 pupils will be using the chip for meals.

Lessons according to a timetable will begin on the 5th of September 2023 (usual school uniform, slippers)

School days (regular):

School operates from **7.00 a.m. to 5.00 p.m**.

7.00 – 8.00 a.m. morning School Club
 From 8.00 a.m. gathering in classrooms
 8.30 a.m. – 2.35 p.m. lessons for Years 1-4

• 8.30 a.m. – 2.35 (alt. 2.55) p.m. lessons for Years 5-9 according to timetable

CHANGE: on Mondays, the first lesson begins at 8.15 a.m.

• 2.35 p.m. – 5.00 p.m. School Club + After-school Activities

If siblings finish their lessons at different times, School Club is provided free of charge by the end of lessons of all children.

Your child will need the following supplies throughout the school year. Please make sure to provide these:

- Stationery: a pencil case, colouring pencils, a sharpener, 2 regular pencils number 2, a pen (Year 1 pupils will receive information during the first parents meeting as pen will be used later), a notebook case, notebook and book covers, a regular longer ruler, a triangle ruler, a drafting compass (Year 3-9), a calculator (Year 4 9), pencil 4H and pencil 4B (Year 5 9).
- It is possible to buy covers for Mathematics, English language, Science and Mathematics by Hejný method textbooks at the school reception.
- P.E.: sport shoes with non-marking soles, socks, a plain white T-shirt, sweatpants or leggings, a sweatshirt, a bag/sachet
- Art (Year 1 7 and Year 9): protective clothing (an older T-shirt or an apron), watercolours, tempera colours (good brand recommended), crayons, flat and round brush number 8 and 12, a wide-bottomed water container, a glue stick, play dough (Years 1 4), scissors with a rounded tip, A4 format hard paper (20 pieces), A3 format hard paper (10 pieces), a tablecloth, a black ink, coloured papers.
- Slippers: firm with non-marking soles
- Science lessons (Year 5 9): laboratory coat
- Cover for iPad (Year 3 9) differs according to the iPad type
- Key chain for meals chip.

The school will provide:

- notebooks, activity books and textbooks (pupils will receive these during the first school week)
- iPad for new pupils, which will be provided by the school only once during the pupil's studies at BESST schools
- Chip for meals once during the pupil's studies.

Transport on the routes Piešťany – Trnava, Pezinok – Trnava, Senec – Trnava, etc. and back:

Parents who are interested in organising of common transport have the possibility to meet on the
first school day, the 4th of September 2023 at 10.30 a.m., in our school PC room. School will not
provide these transportation options; however, we happy to provide you the option for this meeting
and finding a solution amongst you. In case you are interested in common transportation, please fill
it in the online form.

School meals:

- All pupils who will be registered can have their meals from the 5th of September 2023, which are provided in the school canteen inside our school building.
- Price for one lunch for Year 1 4 pupils is 2.40 € and for Year 5-9 pupils is 2.60 €.
- Morning snack is served during a break at 10.05 10.20 a.m. Price for the morning snack for Year 1-4 pupils is 0.50 € and for Year 5 9 pupils is 0.60 €.
- Afternoon snack is served from 2.30 p.m. and from 2.55 p.m. Price for the afternoon snack for Year 1 4 pupils is 0.50 € and for Year 5 9 pupils is 0.60 €.
- Fresh juice is served at 9.15 9.20 a.m. Price for the fresh juice is **0.50 €**/1 Dcl.
- Registration for lunch, morning snack, afternoon snack and fresh juice is available through an **online**
- From the 5th of September 2023 all operational registering/cancelling of meals is possible via EduPage until 7.00 a.m. of the given day.
- In case a parent does not cancel their child's meals on time, on this day it is possible to pick up the meal from 11.30 a.m. 1.30 p.m. in the school canteen. Parents are responsible for cancelling their children's meals in case of their absence in school.
- From the 5th of September 2023 the use of a chip is compulsory for all pupils due to the subsidy settlement and the change of payment form. If a pupil loses or forgets his/her chip, he/she will purchase a new chip at the school reception before lunchtime (the cost of an additional chip is € 2). If the original chip is found and handed in at the reception, the pupil will be refunded €2. If the pupil does not have the cash to buy another chip, the reception will issue the chip to the pupil and the parent/pupil will pay for the chip the next day at the reception. The use of the chip will record the lunch taken in the system, which will then be used to grant the subsidy for the taken lunch.

School Club:

Morning School Club

- Morning School Club operates from 7.00 to 8.00 a.m. in a designated classroom.
- This service is free of charge.
- If you are interested in a regular or irregular morning School Club services, please indicate so in the School Club's electronic application form, which will be sent to you during the first week of September.

Afternoon School Club

School Club begins on the 5th of September 2023.

School Club is available on every school day from the end of the last lesson until 5.00 p.m.

• Children are divided to the School Clubs according to their age.

 The service of the School Club for one day (e.g. every Monday in month) is 20 € per month, 2 days per week 40 € per month, 3 days per week 60 € per month, 4 days per week 80 € per month and whole

month is 95 € per month.

• There is a one-month notice for the School Club and After-school activities permanent cancelation via

a cancelation form. The one month notice begins on the first day of the following month of submitting

of the written cancelation form by the parent.

Motivation System BESST

We would like to inform you that the work of children in the motivation system will be suspended this

school year as the motivation system is undergoing an update in accordance with the school's vision, which will bring improvements in several areas. If your child has been working on projects during the

summer holidays, these projects will be assessed on a one-time basis.

School uniforms:

Pupils of Private Primary and Secondary School BESST wear mandatory school uniforms, which can be purchased in school during all workdays from 7.00 a.m. to 4.30 p.m. The purchase can be in cash or by

credit card.

Pupils must wear uniforms from the second day of school, i.e. the 5th of September 2023.

Payments and pupil's ID:

Payments (except for textbooks and other material) are realized in three instalments for three periods.

For your payments' identification, it is important to use pupil's ID as a variable symbol; payment period and year as a specific symbol; and a purpose of the payment and name of the pupil as a payment subject.

For example: VS: 1111 (pupil's ID)

SS: 012023 (payment period and year)

Note: tuition, Jones (purpose of your payment and name)
